Spartan Academy will empower students to pursue an advanced education and earn an Associate of Science Degree in either Computer Science, Engineering Science or Math/ Science during their four years of high school.

Imagine the Opportunity:

The ESM Spartan Academy is a student-centered school within ESM Central High School that is connected to Onondaga Community College (OCC). Learning will be relevant and engaging. Student curiosity will be sparked and diversity celebrated. It's a computer science and STEM-focused pathway with college courses that will result in an Associate of Science Degree as well as a high school Regents Diploma. All three degrees offered will prepare students to transfer to a four-year college or start a career.

Who Attends Spartan Academy?

This new ESM Early College High School program is open to incoming ninth graders starting in the fall of 2018 who are eager to acquire their high school Regents Diploma and go the extra mile to earn a college-level Associate of Science Degree. The program will serve students who are willing to commit themselves to a four-year rigorous academic, college and career-readiness program. A designated number of students will be admitted and an application is required.
