Good afternoon Lyncourt School Community this is Mr Austin with an important update on our Orange zone designation.

This message only pertains to those families whose child or children attend Lyncourt School in our in-person/hybrid learning model. This does not pertain to our remote learners.

On Monday, November 23rd, Governor Cuomo announced that Lyncourt UFSD is now included in the new coronavirus orange zone. The new orange zone includes most of the city of Syracuse, plus portions of DeWitt and Lyncourt.

As per orange zone guidance Lyncourt School was closed for in-person instruction from November 25th -November 29th. A deep cleaning and sanitization is being done as usual for the entire building during the closure.

On Monday, November 30th ALL Lyncourt staff and in-person/hybrid students UPK-grade 4 as well as 5th-8th grade day 2 students will be tested. You may attend the testing with your child if you so choose.

5th-8th grade Day 1 students will be tested on Tuesday, December 1st.

After our initial test, we will continue testing 25% of our staff/students in school weekly as per the orange zone regulations.

WE need your help for a smooth testing day. Please sign your child up for a test and send them to school at their normal arrival time. Mrs. Davis will email the registration link home and it will also be on our website as soon as we receive it from the County. ALL students will enter the building through the back door of the large gym at their regularly scheduled start time in the morning.

AGAIN, all students need to be signed up for a test. Do not worry about what time slot the site provides you as this just secures a test for you with the county.

If you would like to opt out of the required testing, you will automatically become a remote learner and will begin remote instruction. This is under the order of the Governor. Please let Mrs. Davis know if this is your prerogative.

I would like to thank onondaga county for getting us the first available test date so our students can continue with our in-person/hybrid instruction model.
