## SUBJECT: AWARDS AND RECOGNITION FOR ACCOMPLISHMENT

The Board of Education recognizes individuals for their achievements, meaningful contributions, standards of dedication and accomplishments which favorably reflect an the whole character of the School District, the larger community, the state or the nation. These outstanding services may include, but are not limited to, areas such as art, music, science, math, literature, civics or their related fields.

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to recognize these individuals by means of an award. Such awards may include: an honorary diploma or degree, plaque, certificate of recognition for accomplishment, dedication of a room, library, building or athletic field.

Any school or community member may nominate or recommend an individual to the Superintendent. Selection of candidates will be made by the Superintendent, members of the administrative and teaching staff, or a committee designated by the Superintendent.

Upon receipt of recommendations, the Superintendent will submit to the Board the names of each candidate nominated to receive an award or recognition by the District. Such recognition shall be conferred at a date, designated by the Board.
