- College Courses (OCC, CCC, ESF, SUPA)
 - Offer 24 courses for a total of 77 credit hours
- Graduation Class of 2017
 - 120 students earned college credit (100% of cohort)
 - 24 students earned between 30 and 49 credits
 - 26 students earned between 20 and 29 credits
 - 25 students earned between 10 and 19 credits
 - 75 students with greater than 10 credits (63% of cohort)

• Visual and Performing Arts Opportunities

- Dollars for Scholars (Graduating Class of 2017)
 - 126 Students in Class of 2017
 - \$138,475 Given in Scholarships to Seniors
 - 66 Students Received Scholarships (52.4%)
