EXPLANATION OF EXPENDITURES IN THIS CATEGORY (as it relates to the program narrative for this title)
Lyncourt Union Free School District will retain a Teaching Assistant and save the employee from lay-off. This TA will be used to help reduce class sizes in order to comply with CDC guidelines to space students in the classroom. (\$28,600. Yr1: 2020-21) \$28,600.
The district will hire 2 additional classroom Aides to help with social distancing, safe school entry screening protocol, and individual student assistance with both academic and social needs. The district will also hire 2 custodial workers, one to disinfect touchpoints and bathrooms during the school day and one to disinfect classrooms each night, providing a safe environment for instruction and a healthy environment for staff ans students. (\$59,519. Yr1:2020-21; \$85,383. Yr2:2021-22; \$72,276. Yr3:2022-23) \$217,178.
The Lyncourt Union Free School District will provide proper fitting of N-95 masks for the Nurse and helper. To do so, the district will use the services of a medical facility to properly fit the staff for the masks. The school district will open for in-person instruction, however the students will not change classes in an effort to minimize cross exposure. The district will contract services to re-set the bells and silence them for the school year. This will provide less interuption and continuity in the students instructional day. (\$312. Yr1: 2020-21) \$312.
Lyncourt Union Free School District will reopen in September, 2020 for Inperson instruction grades PreK-4th grade and every other day sychronous instruction for grades 5-8. We are a PreK- 8 school. To do so, we will purchase cleaning supplies, desks for distancing, touchiess thermometers, PPE, air filters, food carts and trash cans for classroom delivery of breakfast and lunch, signage to keep students distanced, storage carts for PPE at each door, polycarbonate barriers, technology for specialized instruction. The district will also use some of these grant funds to provide tactile and sensory technology equipment for special education needs. (\$101,211. Yr1: 2020-2021) \$101,211.
